### Updates for 2005

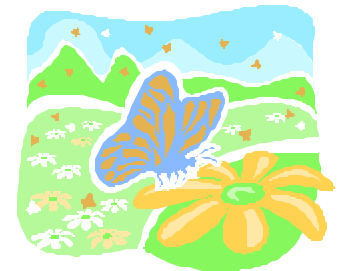
